INFANT PLAYGROUND

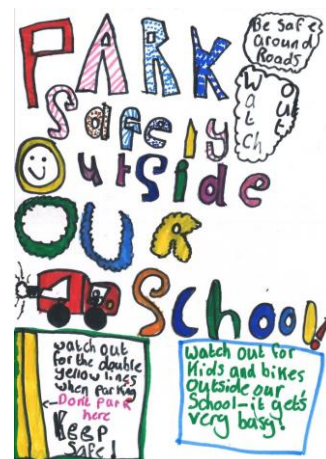
We have a large number of children in the Primary 1 and 2 Playground.

SCHOOL DISCO

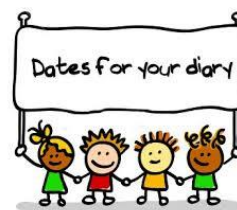
